Your community water and fire services provider requires your time and commitment in order to move forward with the replacement of our water mains and planning a long term sustainable Capital Works Renewal schedule and future long term financial plans. Please consider getting involved. Work with your neighbors to create effective, economical solutions for all Ships Point Improvement District ratepayers.

One vacancy for Trustee needs to be filled for a three year term expiring at the AGM in 2016.

Candidate Eligibility:

To qualify as a candidate one must be:

- 1) A Canadian Citizen
- 2) 18 years of age or older
- 3) An owner of land or a spouse of an owner in Ships Point Improvement District
- 4) A resident of the province for the previous six months as required in the Elections Act.
- 5) Entitled to be registered as a voter under the B.C. Elections Act.
- Owner of land in the Ships Point Improvement District or their spouse or authorized agent of any board or corporation that is an owner of such land, or legal representative of any owner of such land who has died, become insolvent, or insane, or is entitled to be registered as a voter under the "Provincial Elections Act."





School District 71 Property and our Community Association

Did you know that the property immediately north of the northern driveway access to the playing field and Spirit Grove garden, is owned by School District 71, as it was the former site of the Fanny Bay school, which closed many years ago? Fanny Bay Community Association has had a formal lease on the property for the past 14 years and this is due for renewal at the end of 2014. Recently, the School District advised us of their intention to dispose of this property as surplus to their needs, as the likelihood of there ever being a need for a school again here is very remote, and this parcel would not be large enough anyway. Your board met with SD71 trustees and staff, along with our Regional District Director and CVRD staff, to discuss this development. Your Board members pointed out how this property is integral to our operation and provides access to the upland forests for walkers, ATV and horse riders. The School District people expressed a good understanding of our position and invited us to meet with them again in October to provide our vision for this property to continue to be administered by FBCA. Your Board will be developing a response for this meeting through September.



Vivian Cruise has cooked many delightful meals for Movie Nights, and other fund raising events and she advises on kitchen equipment.


