COVID Safety Rules:

1. Do NOT enter parade if you or anyone in your group has any COVID-19 symptoms or has been asked to self-isolate due to possible exposure to COVID-19 within the past 14 days.
2. All participants must obey BCCDC COVID-19 safety guidelines while on FBCA property.
3. No handing or throwing of candy or other treats to people in audience vehicles. Treats will be handed out by FBCA volunteers at the last display along the parade route.
4. All people associated with each decorated vehicle must be in costume, and wear a non-medical mask when social distancing is not possible.
5. All participants must remain behind the marked parade boundary while audience vehicles pass by.

Parade rules:

1. Entries will be limited to pre-registered vehicles. All vehicles must be turned off for duration of event.
2. This is a family event, so no overly scary or inappropriate adult themes allowed. The event planning group has the right to deny entry if a theme is deemed inappropriate.
3. No open flames, fireworks, flammable materials, or noisy generators allowed. No electricity available.
4. Music allowed, but must stay at reasonable level and played only while an audience vehicle is viewing your display.
5. Area open for parking and decorating Noon- 2:30 pm October 31. Vehicles must remain in place until the last audience vehicle finishes touring the parade and exits the area (about 6:30pm.)
6. Participants must ensure their assigned area is cleaned and all trash removed prior to leaving the grounds.
7. No alcohol, marijuana, or other drugs allowed on FBCA grounds for duration of event.
8. If you are representing a business, you are welcome to display a sign advertising your business.
