A Wellhead Protection Plan was discussed, and it was decided that Pat McLean will email Ella at VIHA to let her know we have installed cement barricades in front of the sheds and the wellhead casings are kept bolted and locked.

A new steel door is ready to be installed on the control shed for safety.
There have been two leaks in the last year near the mailboxes on Station Road. Dave Shepherd has asked the school to inform the parents once again they must not park on the grass just above the mailboxes. Canwest has already complied with this, and their employees now park at the Fanny Bay Hall and are bused to their location. Wayne Rideout has also installed cement blocks around this area.

The sublease is still to be completed and Pat McLean will set a date to meet with Wayne to complete this so construction can begin on the office.

There was further discussion on repairing the meter box at Canwest. Wayne will go have a look at it, but the consensus is that there is not much that can be done to make it easier to access.

Good progress has been made on our priority repair list with 4 out of 10 projects completed (list attached).
Dave Shepherd will arrange a full Chemical scan on both wells soon. Pat will check on the cost and advise.
